**DR. KENNETH HEILMAN**

Dr. Kenneth Heilman is Professor of Neurology and Psychology at the University of Florida and Director of the Center for Neuropsychological Studies at the University of Florida Medical Center in Gainesville, Florida. He received his M.D. from the University of Virginia School of Medicine, did an internship at Cornell of Bellevue Hospital in New York, and completed a residency at Harvard Neurologic Unit of Boston City Hospital in Massachusetts. Dr. Heilman is an internationally renowned behavioral neurologist particularly for his work on the processing of emotion, neglect, and apraxia. Dr. Heilman has been a member of the Neurobiology Review Group for the National Institutes of Health and a member of the Neurology Committee for the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology.
